Scottish numbers: 25 January 2021

Summary

- 752 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 10,326 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 8.6% of these were positive
- 4 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 151 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 2,016 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 415,402 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 5,538 have received their second dose
