Scottish numbers: 28 January 2021

Summary

- 1,201 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 25,955 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 5.6% of these were positive
- 82 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 142 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,983 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 462,092 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 6,596 have received their second dose (as at 8:30am on Wednesday 27 January)

Unfortunately due to an IT issue overnight we have been unable to verify the full number of vaccinations recorded yesterday (27 January). All vaccinations carried out yesterday (27 January) will be captured in the update that will run this evening and will reported tomorrow (as at 8:30am on Friday 29 January). No data will have been lost as a result of this IT issue. Normal reporting will resume tomorrow and the daily update published at 2pm.
