Scottish numbers: 30 January 2021

Summary

- 994 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 22,056 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 5.5% of these were positive
- 60 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 142 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,952 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 543,370 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 7,638 have received their second dose
