Scottish numbers: 1 February 2021

Summary

- 848* new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 10,511* new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 9.5% of these were positive
- 6 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 143 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,958 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 575,897 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 7,849 have received their second dose

*Please note that no data has been received from the NHS Tayside laboratory since Saturday 30th January though positive cases for Tayside will continue to rise as other labs continue to report these tests.
