## Scottish numbers: 5 February 2021

### Summary

- 895 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 21,943 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 4.9% of these were positive
- 61 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 123 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,794 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 742,512 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 9,529 have received their second dose
