Scottish numbers: 14 February 2021

Summary

- 903 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 13,808 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 7.3% of these were positive
- 4 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends).
- 104 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,442 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,223,774 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 14,281 have received their second dose
