## Scottish numbers: 19 February 2021

### Summary

- 885 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 23,231 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results – 4.4% of these were positive
- 31 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 98 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,222 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,386,152 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 29,015 have received their second dose
