Summary

- 655 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 16,031 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 4.8% of these were positive
- 56 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 93 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,076 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,465,241 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 43,203 have received their second dose
