# Scottish numbers: 28 February 2021

## **Summary**

- 572 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 17,663 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 3.8% of these were positive
- 2 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 78 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 837 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,593,695 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 76,512 have received their second dose
