## **Summary**

- 386 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 9,982 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 4.5% of these were positive
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 71 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 824 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,593,695\* people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 76,512 have received their second dose
- \* Due to IT issues, the latest vaccinations data relates to the position as at 7:30am on Sunday 28 February. Work is ongoing to resolve these issues and an update will be published as soon as the data is available.
