Scottish numbers: 4 March 2021

Summary

- 500 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 24,723 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results – 2.5% of these were positive
- 24 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 68 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 726 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,688,608 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 100,058 have received their second dose
