# Scottish numbers: 5 March 2021

## **Summary**

- 498 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 19,132 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 3.1% of these were positive
- 11 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 64 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 666 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,717,672 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 108,197 have received their second dose
