Scottish numbers: 7 March 2021

Summary

- 501 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 11,529 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 5.0% of these were positive
- 1 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 59 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 654 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,774,659 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 118,732 have received their second dose
