### **Summary**

- 624 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 26,282 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 2.7% of these were positive
- 7 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 38 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 405 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 2,023,002 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 192,100 have received their second dose
