Scottish numbers: 22 March 2021

Summary

- 359 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 10,759 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results – 3.7% of these were positive
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (Noting that registry offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 33 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 353 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 2,182,400 people have received the first dose of the Covid vaccination and 225,096 have received their second dose
