Following data quality improvement work, the numbers of people classified as care home residents has increased compared to figures presented before 20th March. ## Weekly summary

As at the week ending 04 April 2021, a total of 1,959,684 doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 1,959,684 doses given nationally, 1,491,016 were first doses and 468,668 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.
