As at the week ending 11 April 2021, a total of **2,120,647** doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 2,120,647 doses given nationally, 1,588,499 were first doses and 532,148 were s
