As at the week ending 18 April 2021, a total of 2,299,268 doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 2,299,268 doses given nationally, **1,693,016** were first doses and **606,252** were s
