Weekly summary

The below weekly summary shows total doses of Coronavirus vaccine administered by health board, and is updated every Thursday

As at the week ending 30 May 2021, a total of 3,261,518 doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 3,261,518 doses given nationally, 2,146,126 were first doses and 1,115,392 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.
