

## Daily summary

Individuals who have received a first dose of COVID-19 vaccine\* **2,237,710**

Individuals who have received a two dose course of COVID-19 vaccine\* **1,517,604**

\*These figures are a daily cumulative snapshot of vaccinations given and recorded electronically as at 22:00 yesterday. Data entry will be incomplete at time of this daily report and the number of people vaccinated will be higher than these totals. Ongoing data entry will feed through into future updates. The data in this table are deduplicated so that people should not be double-counted, even if they appear in multiple priority groups.

## Uptake by priority group and age, counting individuals in all groups in which they belong

In this table groups are not mutually exclusive, so individuals appear in every group that describes them, and can be counted in more than one group. This is a 'public health' view, showing the total numbers in each priority group.

The table above presents a public health measure of coverage for each listed priority group, where the % vaccinated out of all those with that specific risk is calculated. The number entered in the 'Group size' column refers to all those with the specific risk that places them in their priority group, as recorded in the Welsh Immunisation System (WIS). Individuals who belong to more than one priority group will appear in more than one line in the table. For example, a person age 52 with a condition that places them at moderate risk will be counted in the group for 'moderate risk adults, 16 years to under 65 years' and also in the '50-54 years' group. In national and health board totals (in weekly reports), individuals are deduplicated so that they are only counted once.

## Uptake by priority group and age, counting individuals once only in their highest priority group

In this table groups are mutually exclusive, so individuals are counted in one group only, which is their highest priority group. This is a 'programme' view, showing actual group numbers remaining after excluding those prioritised earlier in the campaign.

The table above presents a 'mutually exclusive', programme-view of coverage for each group, where individuals are only included in one group according to their highest level of risk. For any priority group the 'Group size' number will not include individuals if they are also in a higher priority group, for this reason, going from top to bottom, group sizes will be smaller than those in the previous table. Individuals who belong to more than one priority group in WIS will not appear in more than one line in the table. The group size figure for social care workers is likely to underestimate the actual number in Wales, as recording of this data is likely to be incomplete.

Data are provisional and undergoing continuous cleaning, this will result in fluctuations in group size and vaccination totals on a daily basis. The sum of the individual rows will not be the same as the national total for vaccinations given, due to suppression of data for a small number of groups where the denominator size is small.

## Weekly summary

The below weekly summary shows total doses of Coronavirus vaccine administered by health board, and is updated every Thursday.

As at the week ending 13 June 2021, a total of **3,609,402** doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 3,609,402 doses given nationally, 2,215,278 were first doses and 1,394,124 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.

The figures in the first table above includes 34,041 people who received their vaccination in Wales, but who were resident outside of Wales. Data source: Welsh Immunisation System (WIS) as at 16/06/2021. Data are subject to revision as WIS data entry is completed and data quality checks are carried out.
