## Weekly summary

The below weekly summary shows total doses of Coronavirus vaccine administered by health board, and is updated every Thursday

As at the week ending 13 June 2021, a total of 3,609,402 doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 3,609,402 doses given nationally, 2,215,278 were first doses and 1,394,124 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.
