As at the week ending 15 August 2021, a total of **4,460,885** doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System

Of the 4,460,885 doses given nationally, 2,312,063 were first doses and 2,148,822 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.
