#### Weekly summary

As at the week ending 12 September 2021, a total of 4,569,835 doses of COVID-19 vaccine were given in Wales and recorded in the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System.

Of the 4,569,835 doses given nationally, 2,363,761 were first doses and 2,206,074 were second doses.

Data entry at time of reporting will be incomplete and the number of people actually vaccinated will be higher. The figures below represent a weekly snapshot in activity recorded electronically. Ongoing data entry for vaccinations already given will feed through into future weekly updates.
