



Wales COVID-19 Vaccination Weekly Surveillance Summary

This report summarises progress in the COVID-19 vaccination programme in Wales. Data are undergoing continuous quality assurance and will be subject to revision in the future.

This report will be added to as further data on vaccinations in recommended priority groups become available.

All data in this report come from the electronic Welsh Immunisation System (WIS) provided by the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS). Data for this report were extracted at **8am 03/03/2021** and include vaccinations given and recorded in WIS up to the end of **Sunday 28/02/2021**. Not all data for vaccinations are entered electronically into WIS at the point of vaccination and there will be paper forms yet to enter for vaccinations given up to Sunday.

Figures presented here are based on all vaccinations entered in to WIS. A small proportion of vaccinations may not have been entered when the data was extracted, and those data will feed into future reports.




Figure 1. Cumulative number of doses given, by week*

Uptake figures now exclude data on those who have died from any cause. This planned development was applied retrospectively on 2 March 2021 and has resulted in 'one-off' increases in uptake in older age groups and in care home residents, as a result of cumulative data changes since reporting began in December 2020. This provides a more accurate picture of vaccination coverage in the current Wales resident population. This does not affect overall numbers of doses given as presented in Table 1 and Figure 1 of this report.

Headline summary

As at the week ending 3rd March 2021, a total of 1,032,133 doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been given in Wales.

A total of 928,213 people have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine; 824,293 people have received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine and 103,920 have completed a two dose course.

Notes

Denominator and numerator data used in this report are sourced from the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System (WIS). WIS contains data for individuals registered in for NHS care in Wales, or who provide frontline health or social care for organisations in Wales. Surveillance data are presented by health board area of residence for all groups apart from health and social care staff and care home workers. Data on health care, social care and care home staff data within WIS are not complete. The completeness and quality of data within WIS are currently being assured and improved in work led by the NWIS, working with Public Health Wales, health boards and NHS trusts.

Where currently possible, data are presented by groups recommended to be prioritised for vaccination by the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI): https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/priority-groups-for-coronavirus-covid-19-vaccination-advice-from-the-jcvi-30-december-2020

Data presented in table 1 are deduplicated so that individuals should only be counted once in the totals for first and second doses.

Data presented in table 2 are not deduplicated so that individuals will be counted more than once if they in more than one risk group.

Data presented in tables 3 to 15 are deduplicated within the table group, but not between the groups presented in other tables and individuals will appear in more than one table if they have multiple risks.

The next priority group tables to be added to this report with be: uptake in those aged 16-50 years and vaccinations given to individuals recorded in WIS as social care workers.
