



Wales COVID-19 Vaccination Weekly Surveillance Summary

This report summarises progress in the COVID-19 vaccination programme in Wales. Data are undergoing continuous quality assurance and will be subject to revision in the future.

This report will be added to as further data on vaccinations in recommended priority groups become available.

All data in this report come from the Welsh Immunisation System (WIS) provided by the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS). Data for this report were extracted at 8am 23/06/2021 and include vaccinations given and recorded in WIS up to the end of Sunday 20/06/2021. Not all data for vaccinations are entered electronically into WIS at the point of vaccination and there will be paper forms yet to enter for vaccinations given up to Sunday.

Figures presented here are based on all vaccinations entered in to WIS. A small proportion of vaccinations may not have been entered when the data was extracted, and those data will appear in future reports.

Uptake figures exclude those who have died from any cause. This planned development was applied retrospectively on 2 March 2021 and has resulted in 'one-off' increases in uptake in older age groups and in care home residents, as a result of cumulative data changes since reporting began in December 2020. This provides a more accurate picture of vaccination coverage in the current Wales resident population. This does not affect overall numbers of doses given as presented in Table 1 and Figure 1 of this report.

Headline summary

As at the week ending 20/06/2021:

A total of **3,757,300** doses of COVID-19 vaccine had been given in Wales.

A total of **2,235,620** people had received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine; of whom **1,521,680** had completed a two dose course.





Notes

Denominator and numerator data used in this report are sourced from the COVID-19 Welsh Immunisation System (WIS). WIS contains data for individuals registered in for NHS care in Wales, or who provide frontline health or social care for organisations in Wales. Surveillance data are presented by health board area of residence for all groups apart from health and social care staff and care home workers. Data on health care, social care and care home staff within WIS are not fully complete. The completeness and quality of data within WIS are constantly being assured and improved in work led by the NWIS, working with Public Health Wales, health boards and NHS trusts. Staff priority groups' uptake can be presented by location of work once data quality issues are resolved.

Where possible, data are presented by groups recommended to be prioritised for vaccination by the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI):

Data presented in table 1 are de-duplicated so that individuals should only be counted in one HB and once in the totals for first and second doses. Data presented in table 2 are not de-duplicated so that individuals will be counted more than once if they in more than one priority group. Data presented in tables 3 to 17 are not de-duplicated between tables and individuals may appear in more than one table, for example in an age group table and a clinical risk groups table.
