The Weekly Public Health Report includes enhanced, more granular information to be updated on a weekly, or biweekly basis.

- Cases by sex/race/ethnicity
- Contact tracing cases and outreach
- Individuals released from isolation (recovered)
- Cases and case rate by age for last two weeks
- Probable cases
- Cases and deaths in Long Term Care Facilities
- Infection control survey results at nursing homes
- PPE Distribution

Congregate care and long term care facilities use the County Level Positivity Rates found in this chart to determine whether a sample of staff in their facility or all staff need to be tested as part of the surveillance testing programs.
