

COVID-19 updates.

Updated April 5, 2021

Updated daily at 11 a.m., with data current as of 4 p.m. the previous day. In observance of the holidays, we did not update the data on this page on Sunday, April 4. Today's post will be for data analyzed and reported out as of Saturday, April 3. Due to a technical issue on Saturday, April 3 fewer cases than normal were able to be processed. The numbers posted on Monday, April 5 may be lower and cases posted Tuesday, April 6 may be higher as a result.

Data is for cases that were tested and returned positive. All data is preliminary and may change as cases are investigated. Many data points are collected during case interviews. Data presented below is for all cases, regardless of interview status. Data for cases pending interview may be listed as "unknown/missing."

Positive PCR test results are considered confirmed cases. Positive antigen test results are considered probable cases.

All probable cases get the same public health follow up and recommendations as cases confirmed by PCR tests.

Because all data is preliminary, the change in number of cumulative positive cases and deaths from one day to the next may not equal the newly reported cases or deaths.






