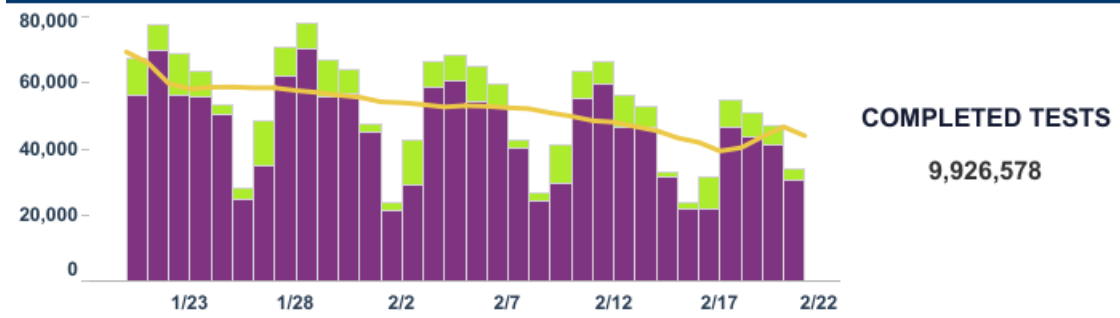

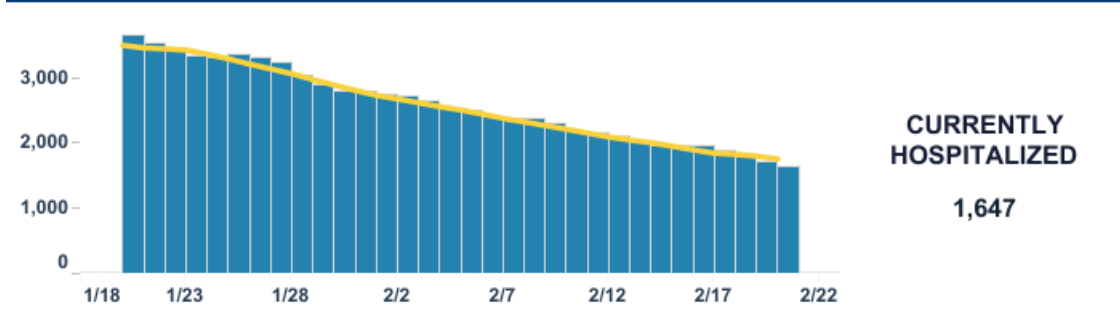
Daily Cases i



Daily Tests i

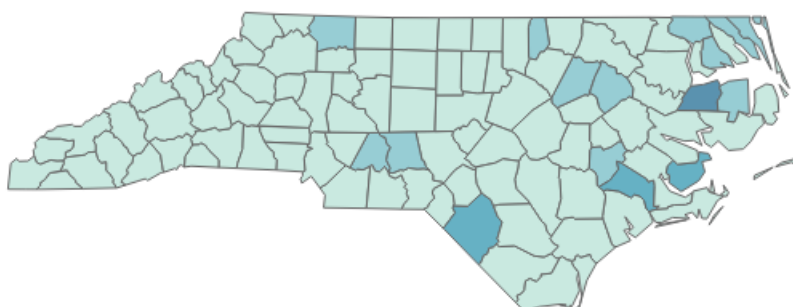


Daily Number of People Currently Hospitalized i
