



Beginning Saturday, March 6, 2021, the NC COVID-19 Dashboards will be published Monday through Saturdays.

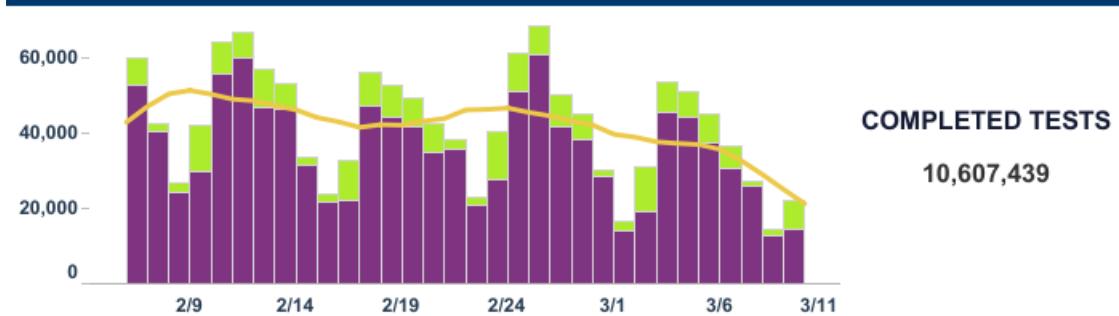

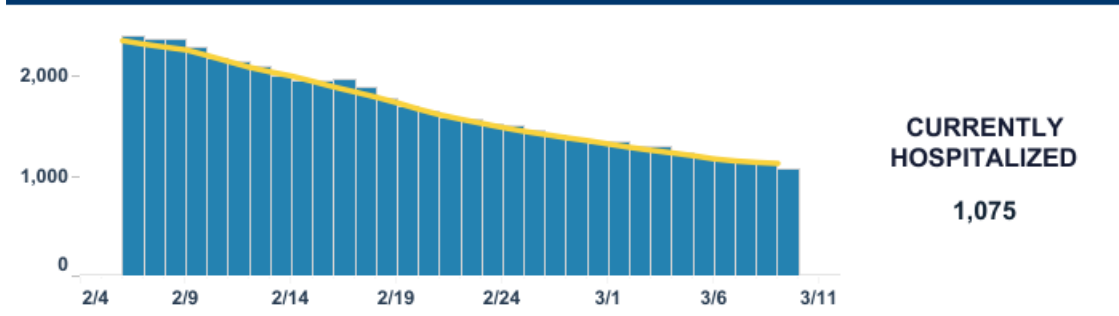
Daily Cases i



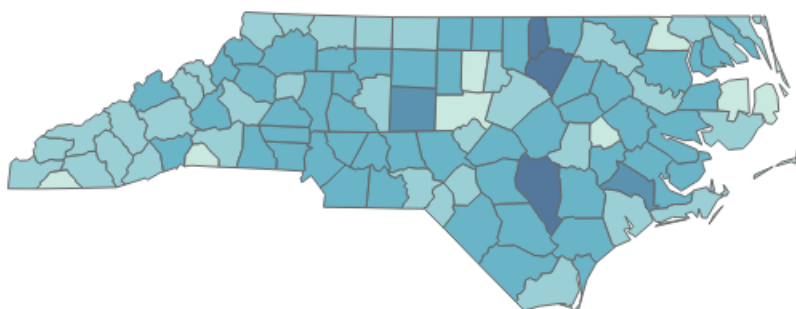
Daily Tests i
