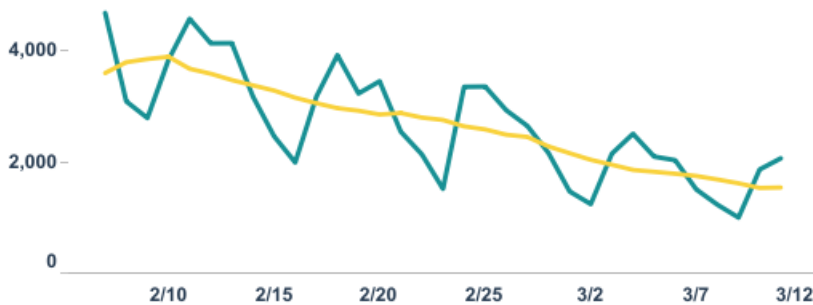
COVID-19 North Carolina Dashboard

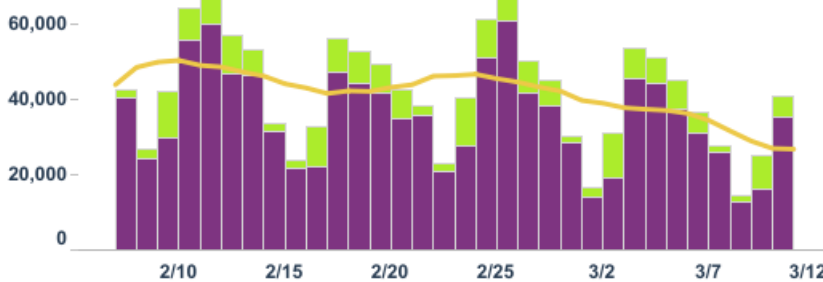

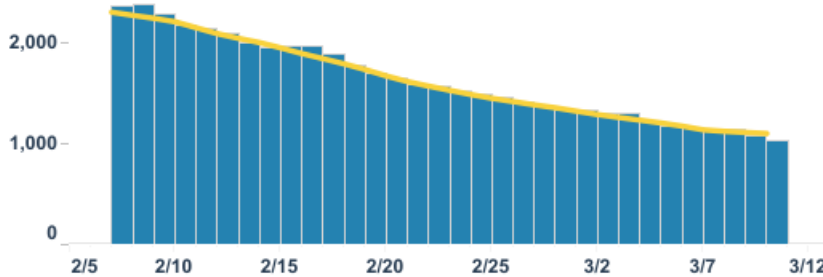

Daily Number of People Currently Hospitalized i



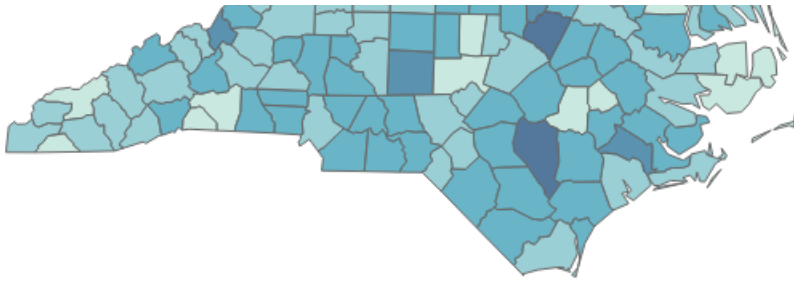
