



# COVID-19 North Carolina Dashboard

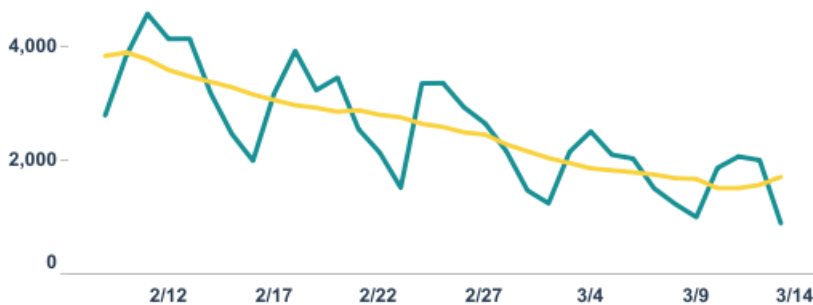
On Mar. 12, 2021, NCDHHS experienced technical issues with the NC COVID reporting system. As a result, case and test counts reported on Mar. 13, 2021 are lower than they would have been had all data been processed at the standard time. Data published on Mar. 15, 2021 will be higher as it will incorporate case and test data that would have been reported on Mar. 13, 2021.

Beginning Saturday, March 6, 2021, the NC COVID-19 Dashboards will be published Monday through Saturdays.

Knowing when to dial up or down measures that slow the spread of the virus depends on North Carolina's testing, tracing and trends. This dashboard provides an overview on the metrics and capacities that the state is following.

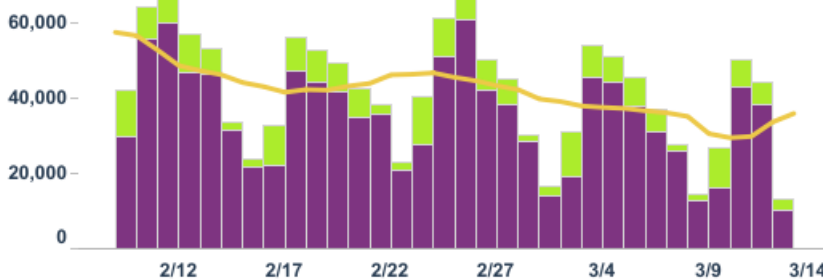

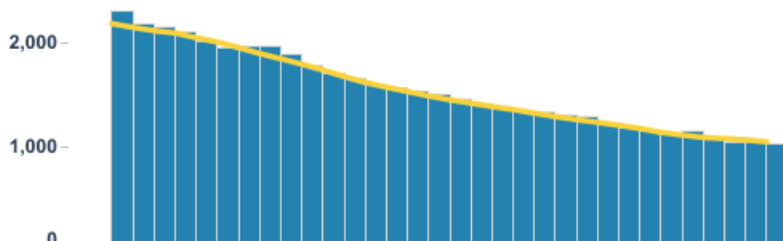

## Daily Number of People Currently Hospitalized i

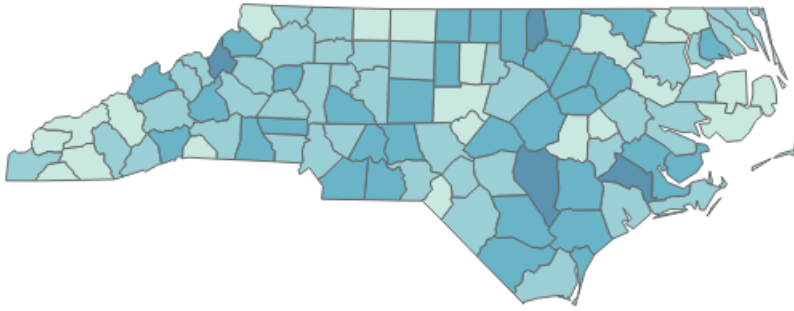
