



# COVID-19 North Carolina Dashboard

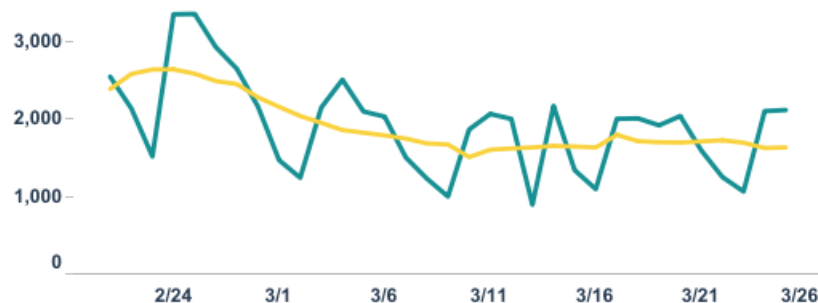
The NC COVID-19 dashboard update on Thursday, March 25, 2021, will include 68 additional deaths identified by Wake County Public Health following a review of their vital records data. 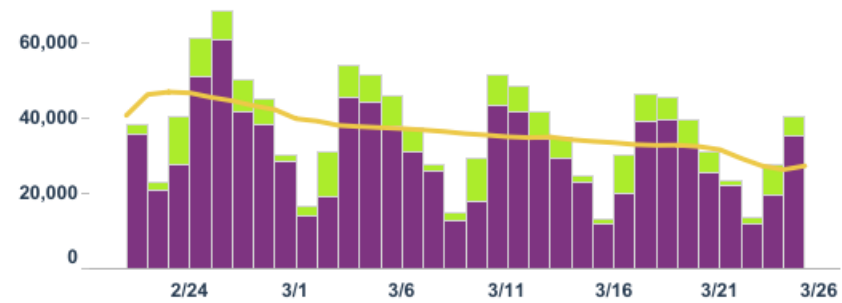

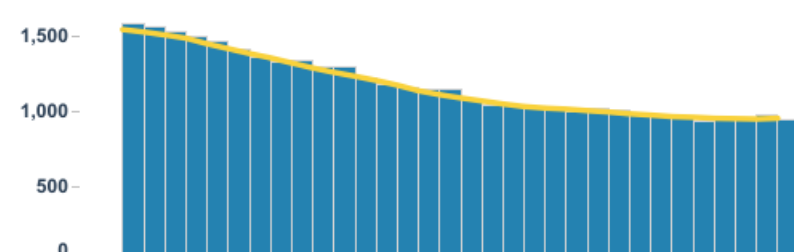

## Daily Number of People Currently Hospitalized i



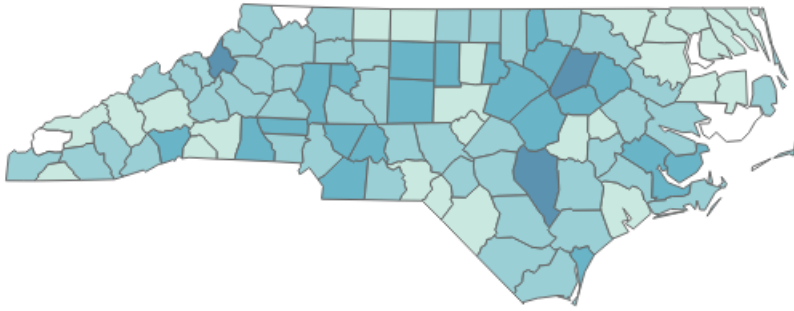
