Call 1-833-4-ASK-ODH (1-833-427-5634) The Call Center is staffed from 9 a.m to 8 p.m each day, including weekends.

The data update for 12/8 includes a backlog of approximately 13,000 antigen test records that date back to November 1, for a total of 25,721 cases reported. These cases have all been assigned to their respective onset dates, and will be displayed that way in any dashboards that use onset date.







30,226 Number of Hospitalizations in Ohio




502 CDC Expanded Death Definition (Probable)
