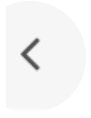



Schools and other specific business sectors can download guidance and requirements for responsible reopening and operation.

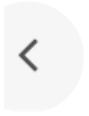
