The Call Center is staffed from 9 a.m to 8 p.m each day, including weekends.

\* Of the 752 deaths being reported, 428 are deaths of Ohio residents who died out of state. Other states do not send these death certificates to ODH's Bureau of Vital Statistics on a regular schedule and therefore fluctuations will be reflected in reported mortality data. Deaths are assigned to their appropriate date of death.

\*\* Case rates per 100,000 are updated weekly on Thursday and are available in Key Measures: Incidence - Cases per 100,000 Over 2 Weeks and Regional COVID-19 ICU Utilization.
