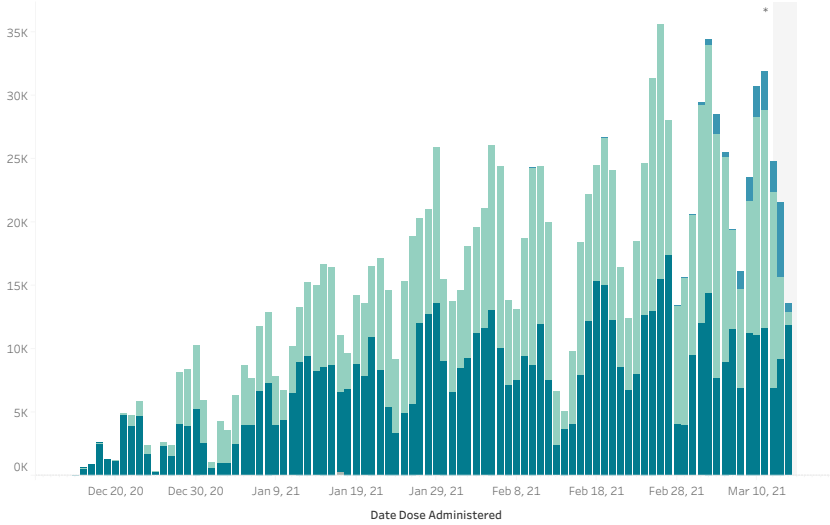

Notes:

Oregon ALERT Immunization Information System (IIS) is a statewide, lifespan immunization registry.

COVID-19 vaccination providers must document vaccine administration in their medical record systems within 24 hours of administration, and use their best efforts to report administration data to ALERT IIS as soon as practicable and no later than 72 hours after administration.

**Doses administered counts the number of vaccines administered; people vaccinated counts the number of unique individuals who received vaccine with valid dose numbers; doses with an invalid dose number, for example due to unresolved duplicate vaccination reports, data entry errors, dose spacing errors, or mixed manufacturers for first and second dose, will not show up in the count for persons vaccinated- it is anticipated that <1% of doses will have an invalid dose number.

†American Indian/Alaska Native may include data reported from the federally recognized Tribes of Oregon.
