

<u>Data Source:</u> Oregon ALERT Immunization Information System (IIS) is a statewide, lifespan immunization registry.

COVID-19 vaccination data are provisional and subject to change. Note on 4/9/2021, the data contained in this data visualization were refreshed with a new extract out of ALERT IIS, meaning the data is more accurate and representative of what is contained in the live system.

COVID-19 vaccination providers must document vaccine administration in their medical record systems within 24 hours of administration, and use their best efforts to report administration data to ALERT IIS as soon as practicable and no later than 72 hours after administration.

eries complete differs from fully vaccinated. Series complete refers to an individual that has received 2 doses of a 2-dose series (Moderna or Pfizer) or 1 dose of a 1-dose series (Johnson & Johnson); people are sidered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after receiving their second dose of a 2-dose vaccine or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine. Per CDC's recommendation, individuals who have not passed the two week window applieting their series are NOT fully vaccinated and should continue taking <u>all precautions</u> until they are fully vaccinated.
