GLOBAL SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Ministry of Health (MOH) is closely monitoring an ongoing pandemic of a coronavirus disease which is affecting over 190 countries globally. The World Health Organization (WHO) declared the outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) on January 30, 2020, designated its official name as Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) on February 11, 2020, and characterized it as a *pandemic* on March 12, 2020.

As of January 29, 2021:

- At least **101,453,597*** confirmed cases of COVID-19 globally, including **7,572**** in Guam, **132** in the Northern Mariana Is. (CNMI), **4** in the Marshall Islands, **1** in the FSM, **25,746** in Hawaii, **519,575** in Philippines, **380,644** in Japan, **895** in Taiwan.
- **2,191,078*** deaths reported globally – **129**** deaths on Guam, **405** in Hawaii, **2** in CNMI, **10,552** in Philippines, **5,503** in Japan, **7** in Taiwan.
- **56,043,612*** people have recovered from COVID-19 globally.

PALAU READINESS AND RESPONSE

As of January 29, 2021:

- There are **NO SUSPECTED** or **CONFIRMED CASES** of COVID-19 in Palau.
- **COVID-19 Vaccination (since Jan. 3, 2021):** **3,109** 1st dose administered; **0** 2nd dose administered; **0** total persons vaccinated (1st + 2nd dose).
- **Isolation & Quarantine:**
 - Currently in Isolation & Quarantine: **35** in quarantine facility, **4** in self-monitoring, **0** in BNH isolation, **0** in alternative care and isolation site
 - Total since Apr. 17, 2020: **0** isolated, **980** quarantined (inbound travellers and PUIs)
- **COVID-19 Testing (since Apr. 14, 2020):** **3,596** tests conducted, **0** positive, **3,596**
 - negative, **0** pending results.
- **International Points of Entry Screening:**
 - Total since Jan. 23, 2020: **200** flights screened, **15,773** travelers; **99** vessels screened, **2,704** travelers; **1,001** secondary screening
- **Belau National Hospital Ventilators:** **0** in use, **30** total capacity - **5** portable, **2** pediatric, **18** adult vents, **5** in calibration

General Updates:

- MOH Emergency Operations Center (EOC) activated on Jan. 22, 2020 to implement preparedness and response measures to minimize the risk of importation and potential local transmission of COVID-19 to Palau.
- MOH issued a *Certification of an Unavoidable Public Health Emergency* for COVID-19 on Mar. 17, 2020.
- MOH issued Directive No. 211-20 effective on November 12, 2020 re-authorizing Belau National Hospital and Public Health Measures in response to COVID-19.
- **MOH received 2nd batch of Moderna COVID-19 vaccines (3,200 doses) on Jan. 14, 2021. Mass vaccination commenced on Jan. 3, 2021 and is ongoing with targeted priority groups.**
- MOH issued Directive No. 1-21 on Jan. 3, 2021 re-authorizing isolation and quarantine measures for COVID-19.
- As COVID-19 mass vaccination is ongoing, the public is urged to continue practicing the following measures to prevent respiratory infections:
 - **Frequent handwashing with soap and water or hand rub with 70% alcohol-based sanitizer.**
 - **Respiratory Etiquettes: Cover cough and sneeze with clean tissue or shirt sleeve.**
 - **Avoid close contact with sick people and stay away from others if you are sick. Call your doctor or hospital for advise.**
 - **Clean/disinfect frequently touched surfaces/objects.**
