The CDC's Long-Term Care Program <<https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/covid-19/long-term-care/pharmacy-partnerships.html>> is a federal partnership between Walgreens and CVS pharmacies. These pharmacies are holding vaccination clinics at every long-term care facility in South Carolina, ensuring those most vulnerable to COVID-19 and the workers who care from them are among the first to receive their shots. CVS and

Walgreens began holding vaccine clinics at these facilities on December 28, 2020. Long-term Care Program data is recorded in a federal database called Tiberius. The information in the spreadsheets below, from Tiberius, isn't managed by DHEC.
