Wyoming COVID-19 Vaccine Information

Key Points:

- Getting vaccinated is free; people receiving COVID-19 vaccines will not be asked to pay any fees.
- There are [many benefits to vaccination](#). COVID-19 vaccines are safe and have been shown to be do an excellent job of keeping you from getting sick with COVID-19.
- It's important to [get the facts about COVID-19 vaccines from trusted sources](#).
- Wyoming is using a phased approach because of limited initial vaccine availability.
- Wyoming counties are currently vaccinating in [priorities 1a and 1b](#).
- **Phase 1a** includes community and tribal healthcare workers involved in direct patient care, residents of Wyoming's long-term care facilities, laboratory staff, pharmacy staff, law enforcement and other first responders.
- **Phase 1b** generally includes people who are 70 years of age or older, frontline essential workers who must interact with the public and are unable to consistently physically distance from others.
- At the state level, we determine priority groups and order vaccine supply. At the [county level](#), we coordinate and administer the vaccine.

- Each of the currently authorized vaccines requires two doses for maximum effectiveness.

COVID-19 Vaccine: What You Need to Know

- Vaccines are currently available in limited supply.
- The vaccine is **FREE**.
- Your insurance status does not affect your ability to receive the vaccine for free.
- Vaccine administration is coordinated locally.
- The vaccine is safe.

First Vaccine Doses Administered: **28,889**

Second Vaccine Doses Received: **18,000** (7,800 Pfizer/10,200 Moderna)

Second Vaccine Doses Administered: **4,525**
