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

- Vaccines are currently available in limited supply (though supply is steadily growing).
 - Because of this, Wyoming counties are vaccinating in phases (en Español).

 - If you have insurance, your insurance can be billed for administration fees. No fees will be billed to you.
 - If you do not have insurance, you will be able to get the vaccine and no fees will be billed to you.
- The vaccines are SAFE.

 - CDC has safety information and guidance to help you prepare for your vaccination.
 - The authorized vaccines require two doses for maximum effectiveness.

Second Vaccine Doses Received: **81,725** (41,925 Pfizer/39,800 Moderna) Second Vaccine Doses Administered: **60,933**

Reporting of administered doses is up to 72 hours behind. Counts do not include federal doses provided separately and directly for tribal, VA, and military facilities.
