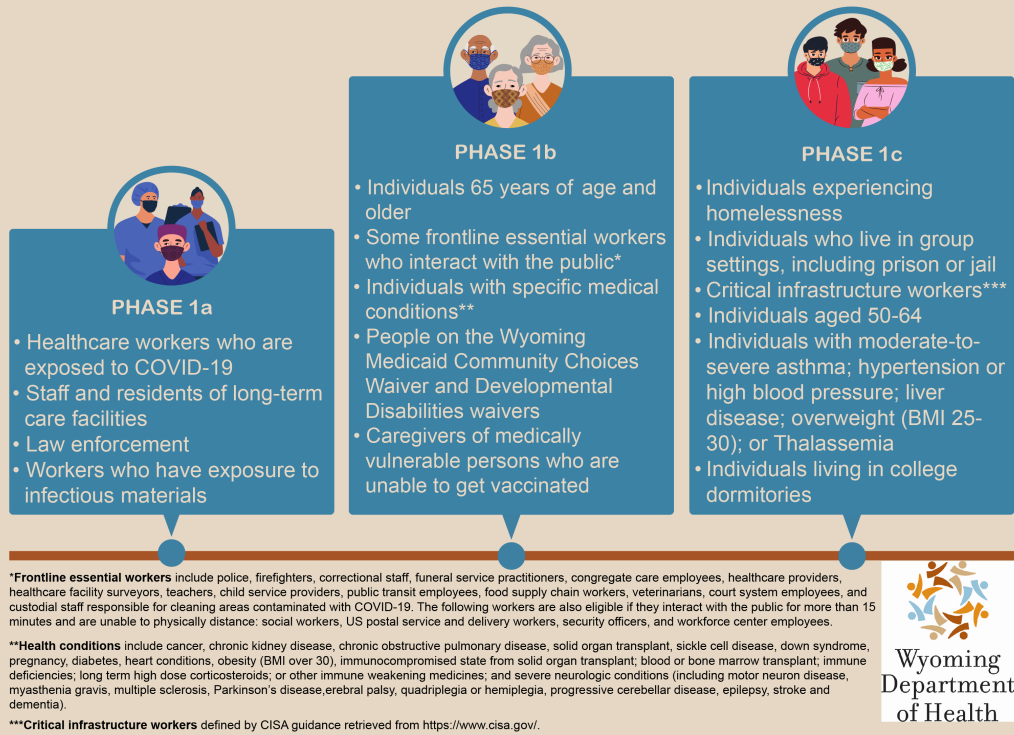


Wyoming COVID-19 Vaccine Information

Two-dose Vaccines

First Vaccine Doses Received: **138,380** (67,080 Pfizer/71,300 Moderna)
First Vaccine Doses Administered: **117,631**

Second Vaccine Doses Received: **99,775** (47,775 Pfizer/52,000 Moderna)
Second Vaccine Doses Administered: **74,399**

One-dose Vaccine

Doses Received: **6,300** (Janssen)
Doses Administered: **1,741**

Reporting of administered doses is up to 72 hours behind. Counts do not include federal doses provided separately and directly for tribal, VA, and military facilities.
