

Counties are working through Wyoming's vaccination effort in phases. Most counties have made progress through Phases 1a through 1c and are beginning to open vaccination clinics and appointments to the general public (residents age 16 and older where Pfizer is available and 18 and older where Moderna and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson is available. Two-dose Vaccines First Vaccine Doses Received: 167,630 (84,630 Pfizer/83,000 Moderna)

First Vaccine Doses Administered: 138,704

Second Vaccine Doses Received: **118,805** (58,305 Pfizer/60,500 Moderna) Second Vaccine Doses Administered: **92,108**

One-dose Vaccine Doses Received: 8,400 (Janssen) Doses Administered: 4,657

Reporting of administered doses is up to 72 hours behind. Counts do not include federal doses provided separately and directly for tribal, VA, and military facilities.
