## Wyoming COVID-19 Vaccine Information

On April 13, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) released a joint statement recommending a temporary pause in the use of the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine to review data involving six reported U.S. cases of a rare and severe type of blood clot in individuals after receiving the J&J vaccine. Wyoming is following this recommendation.

#### What You Need to Know

#### The vaccines are FREE.

- If you have insurance, your insurance can be billed for administration fees. No fees will be billed to you.
- If you do not have insurance, you will be able to get the vaccine and no fees will be billed to you.

#### The vaccines are SAFE.

• CDC has safety information and guidance to answer questions and help you prepare for vaccination.

#### The vaccines WORK!

#### All Wyoming counties are offering vaccines to the general public.

One-dose Vaccine Doses Received: 25,100 (Janssen) Doses Administered: 10,017

Doses administered are **up to 72 hours behind**. Counts do not include federal doses provided to tribal, VA, and military facilities.
