## Wyoming COVID-19 Vaccine Information What You Need to Know

#### The vaccines are FREE and available to EVERYONE.

- If you have insurance, your insurance can be billed for administration fees. No fees will be billed to you.
- If you do not have insurance, you will be able to get the vaccine and no fees will be billed to you.
- Everyone old enough to receive an authorized vaccine is eligible, regardless of immigration or insurance status (fact sheet – EN | ES).

#### The vaccines are SAFE.

• CDC has safety information and guidance to answer questions and help you prepare for vaccination.

#### The vaccines WORK!

- Learn more about COVID-19 vaccination benefits and facts.
- Once you're fully vaccinated, you can resume activities that you did prior to the pandemic.
