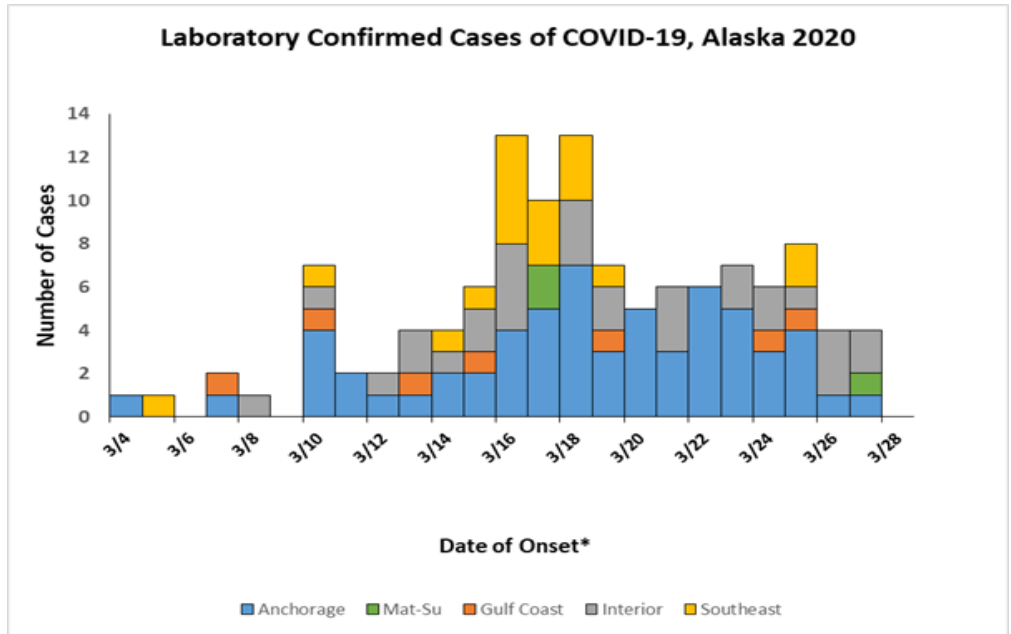

### How many confirmed cases are there in Alaska by region?



\*Cases are assigned by date of onset, diagnosis, or report — whichever is earliest; therefore, case counts may be updated as new data become available.

- > Cumulative number of cases hospitalized to date: 07
- > Cumulative number of deaths to date: 03
- > Updated March 30, 2020; updates made daily by 5pm and reflect cases reported as of 3pm that day.

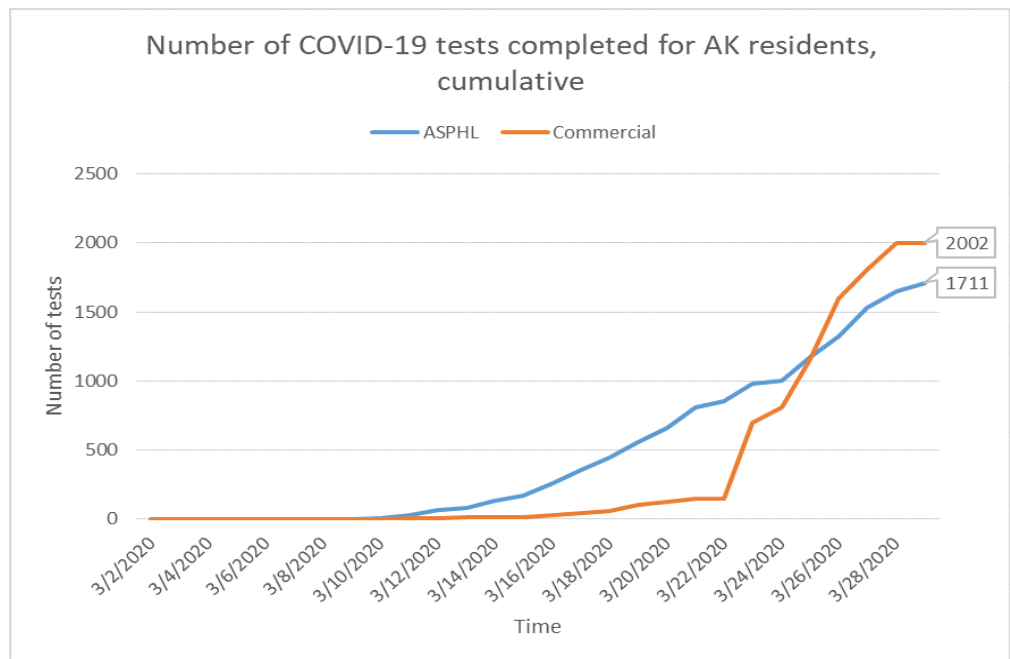

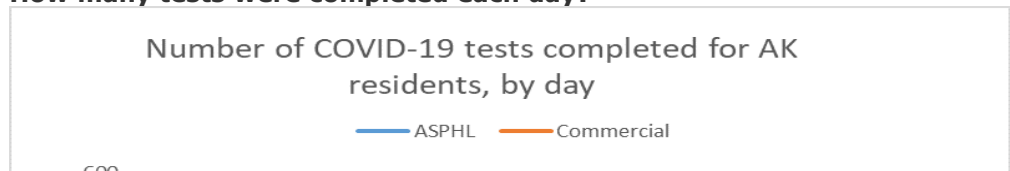

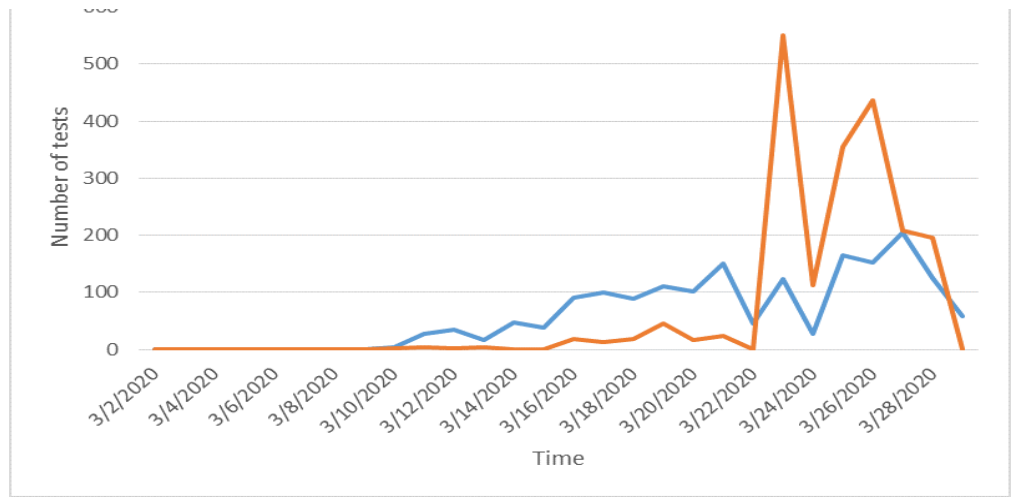
