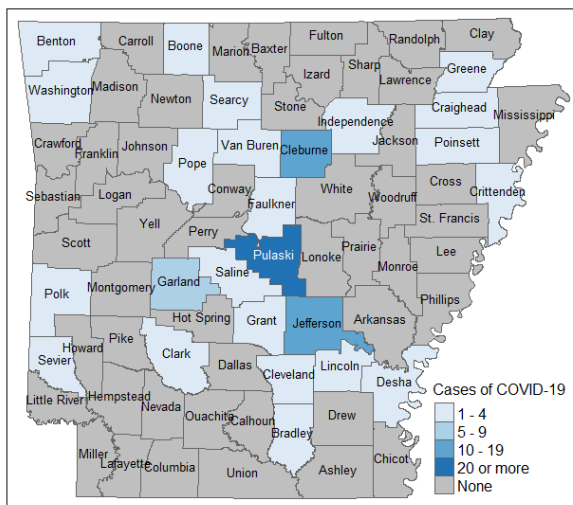

Positives of COVID-19 in Arkansas

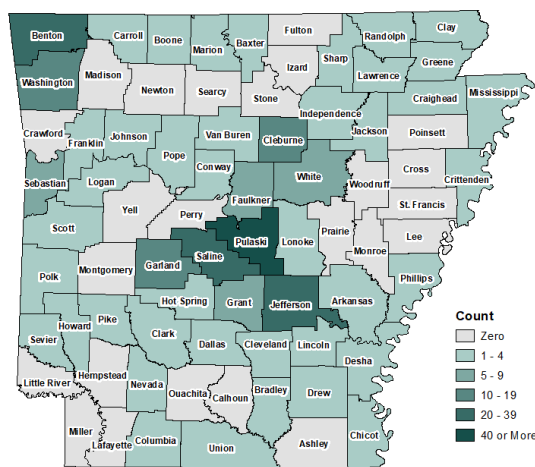
