- Practice social distancing. Avoid close contact with others, especially those who are sick, by keeping at least 6 feet between you and others
- Avoid going out except to get medical care. If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever, cough, or shortness
 of breath, call your health care provider. Your physician will decide if testing is necessary based on your symptoms and known
 exposures.


