Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)

Governor Carney declared a State of Emergency starting on March 13, 2020 at 8 a.m. and updated it on March 16, 2020 and March 18, 2020. **If you are hosting an event with over 50 people, please review the news release and Governor's State of Emergency Declaration.**

Delawareans who are feeling well should go about their daily lives but practice social distancing – staying six feet away from other people.

Those who are feeling sick should stay home, and contact your primary health care provider if you have concerns about your symptoms, particularly those with fever and coughing or shortness of breath.




