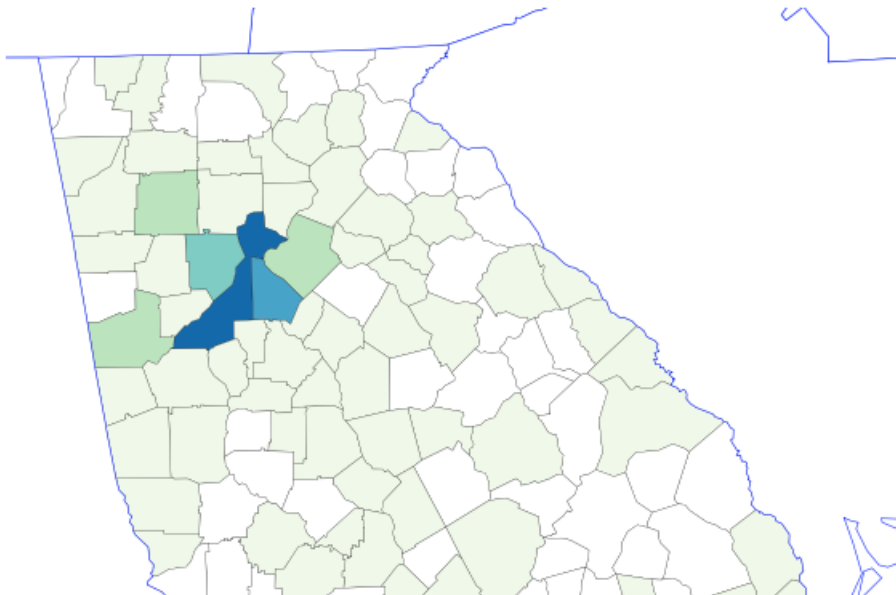

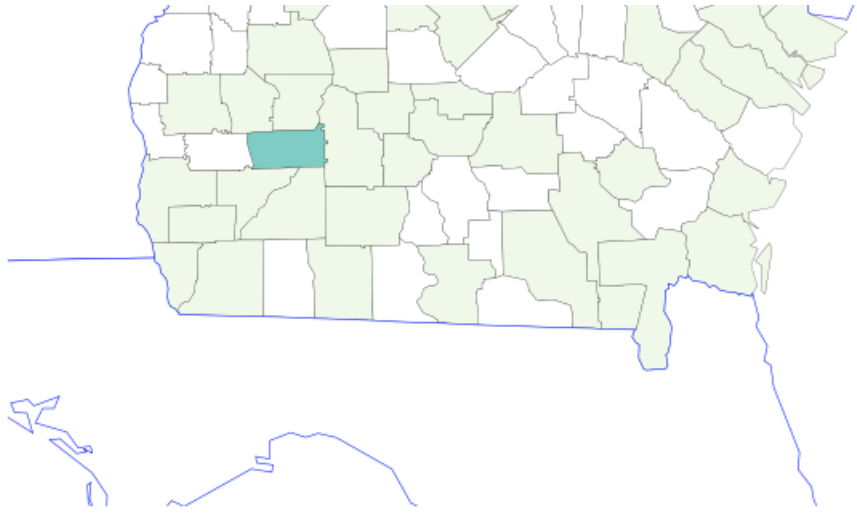

## COVID-19 Confirmed Cases by County





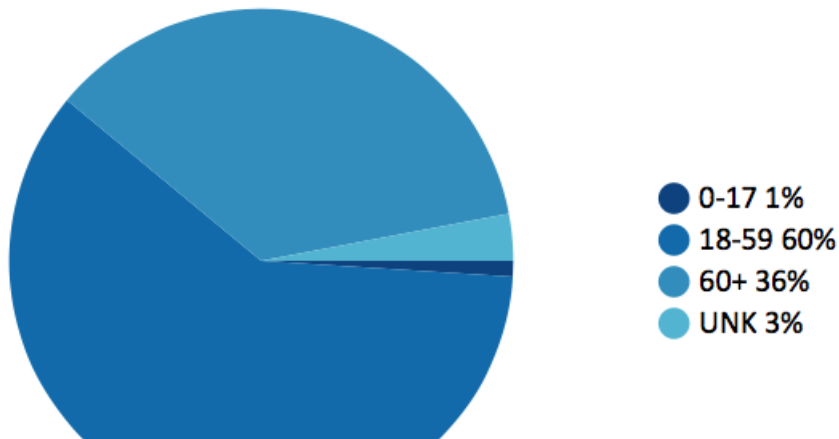
**Count of COVID-19 Confirmed Cases \*Based on patient county of residence when known**

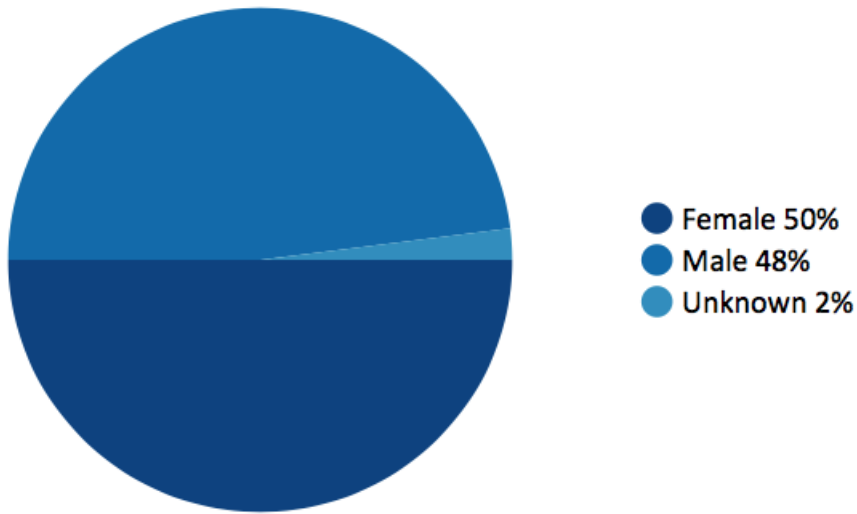
